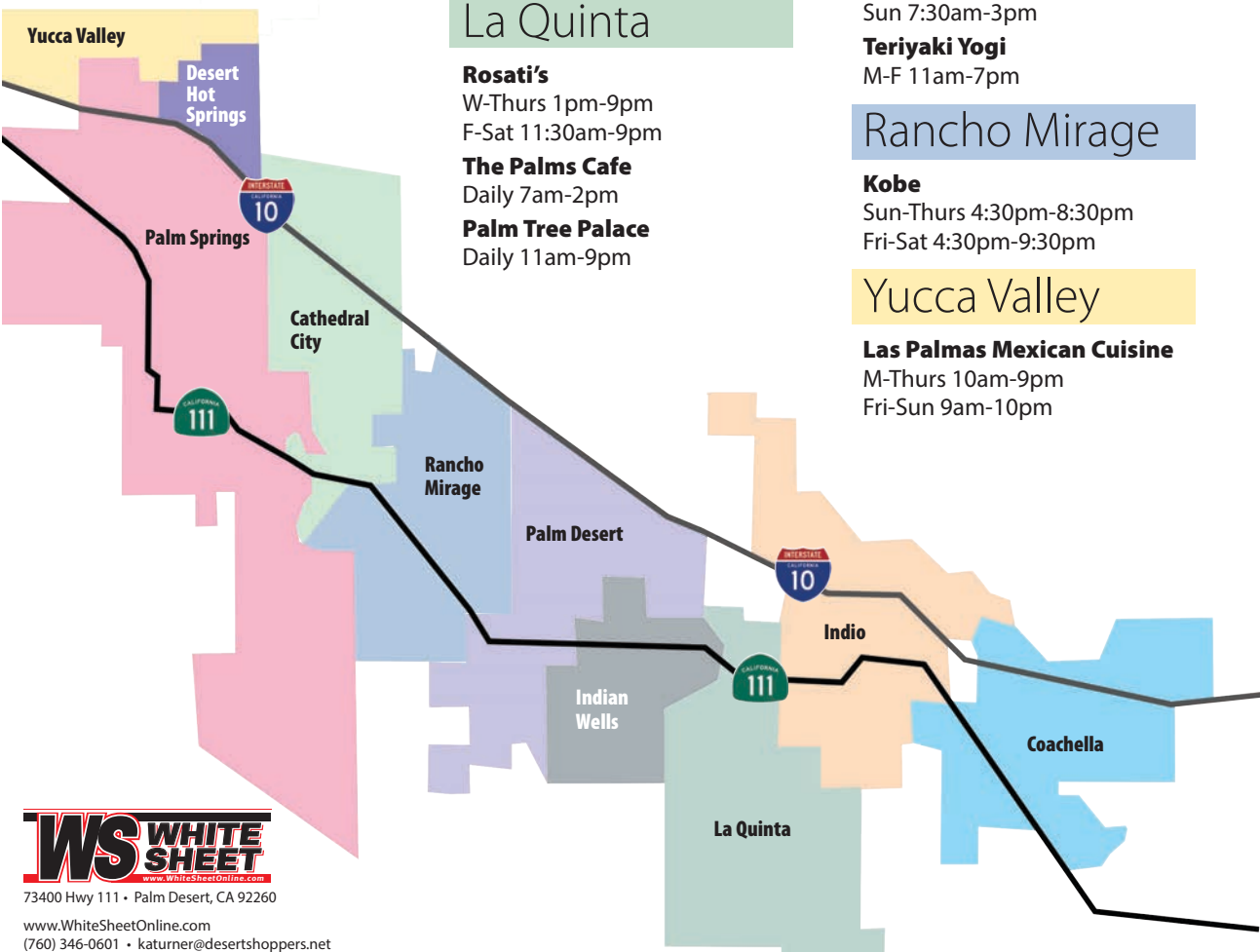

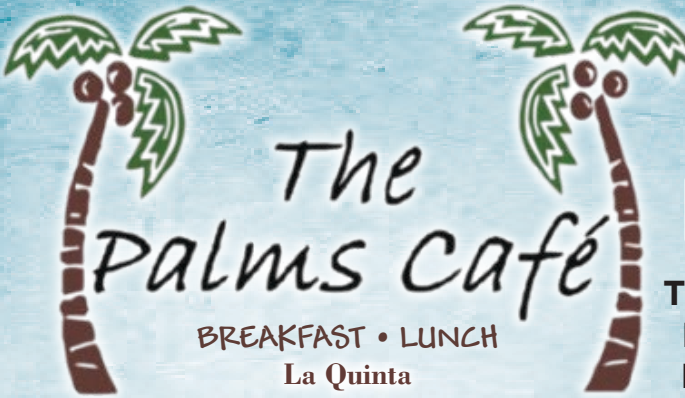

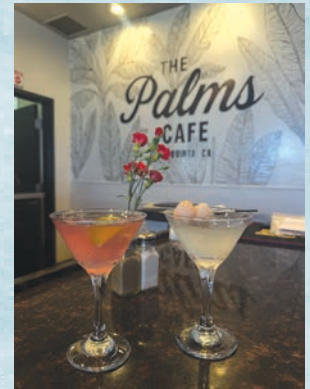

How to Tip When Dining Out

A modern guide to showing appreciation the right way

Tipping while dining out can feel awkward—especially with rising prices, digital screens prompting percentages, and different service styles everywhere you go. But at its core, tipping is about one simple thing: recognizing good service. Knowing when, how much, and why to tip helps diners feel confident and ensures service professionals are fairly rewarded.

Why Tipping Matters

For many restaurant employees, tips make up a significant portion of their income. Servers, bartenders, and other front-of-house staff often earn a base wage that assumes gratuities will make up the difference. A thoughtful tip isn't just polite—it's part of the dining ecosystem.

The Standard Restaurant Tip

In most sit-down restaurants in the U.S., the accepted standard is:

- **15%** for basic or adequate service
- **18–20%** for good service
- **20–25% or more** for exceptional service

These percentages are typically calculated **before tax**, unless the restaurant specifies otherwise.

When Service Goes Above and Beyond

Did your server offer thoughtful recommendations, handle a mistake with grace, or make a special occasion feel memorable? That's your cue to tip on the higher end. Excep-



tional service deserves exceptional recognition.

What About Less-Than-Great Service?

If service truly falls short, it's okay to tip less—but consider the circumstances. Was the restaurant understaffed? Was the kitchen backed up? If the issue was outside your server's control, tipping normally and politely mentioning the issue to a manager is often the better approach.

Tipping in Different Dining Situations

Not all dining experiences are the same, and tipping norms can vary:

- **Bars:** \$1–\$2 per drink or 20% of the tab
- **Buffets:** 10–15%, especially if staff clear plates and refill drinks
- **Takeout:** Optional, but 5–10% is appreciated
- **Delivery:** 15–20%, more for long distances or bad weather
- **Counter service or coffee shops:** Tipping is optional, but a few dollars for good service goes a long way

Digital Tip Screens: Don't Feel Pressured

Tablet screens with preset tipping options are everywhere now. While they can feel awkward, remember—you're not obligated to tip more than you're comfortable with. Choose an amount that reflects the service you received, not the suggested default.

Cash vs. Card

Both are generally acceptable, but cash tips are often preferred by service staff since they may receive them immediately. If paying by card, rest assured most restaurants distribute tips appropriately—though policies can vary.

When Tipping Isn't Required

Some restaurants include a **service charge or automatic**



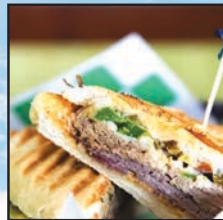
gratuity, especially for large parties. Always check your bill to avoid tipping twice unless you truly want to add extra.

The Bottom Line

Tipping doesn't have to be stressful. When you dine out, tip thoughtfully, fairly, and within your means. A well-placed gratuity not only rewards good service—it helps create a positive dining culture for everyone at the table and beyond.

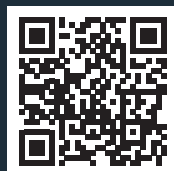

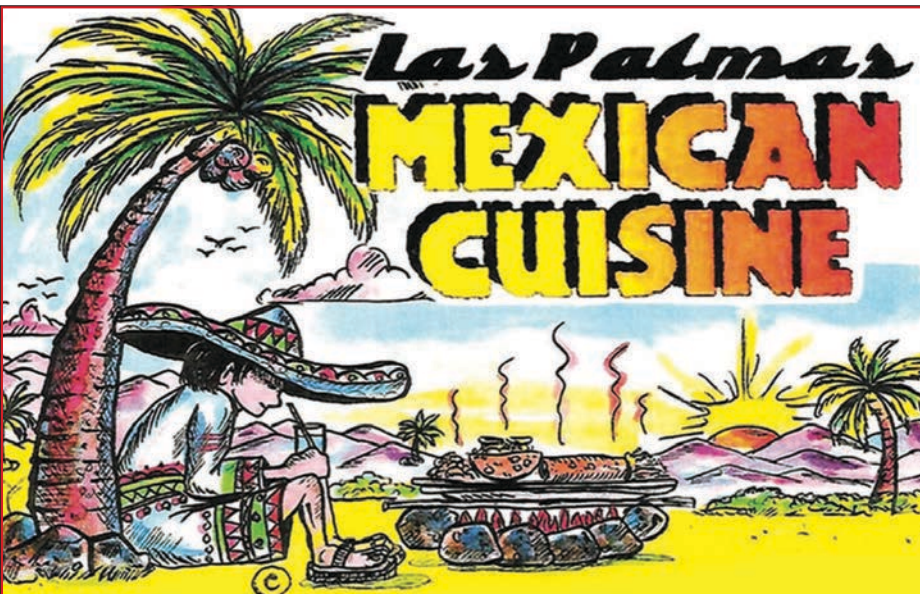

Alcohol Pairing for Meals

Choosing the Right Alcoholic Beverage for a Meal

Selecting the perfect alcoholic beverage to complement a meal can elevate flavors, enhance the dining experience, and even impress your guests. Whether you're dining out or hosting at home, understanding a few simple pairing principles will help you make confident, delicious choices.

Start With the Dish, Not the Drink

The most important rule of pairing is to let the food lead. Consider the main protein, cooking method, sauce, and seasoning. A grilled steak with bold seasoning calls for something very different than a delicate lemon butter fish.

Ask yourself:

- Is the dish light or rich?
- Is it spicy, sweet, creamy, smoky, or acidic?
- Is the protein mild (chicken, white fish) or bold (lamb, beef)?

Matching intensity is key — light dishes pair best with lighter drinks, and hearty meals call for fuller-bodied beverages.

Wine Pairings

White Wine

Best for: Seafood, chicken, salads, creamy pasta, lighter fare

• Sauvignon Blanc

pairs beautifully with citrusy dishes and salads.

- **Chardonnay** complements creamy sauces and roasted poultry.

- **Pinot Grigio** works well with light fish and appetizers.

White wines typically highlight freshness and acidity, cutting through rich sauces and brightening delicate flavors.

Red Wine

Best for: Red meats, hearty pasta, grilled dishes

• Cabernet Sauvignon

is ideal for steak and robust dishes.

• Pinot Noir

pairs well with roasted chicken, pork, and even salmon.

- **Merlot** complements medium-bodied meats and tomato-based pasta.

Red wines generally have more tannins and structure, making them perfect for rich, savory meals.



Beer Pairings

Beer is incredibly versatile and often easier to pair than wine.

• Light Lager or Pilsner:

Great with burgers, pizza, fried foods.

• **IPA:** Pairs well with spicy dishes and bold flavors.

• **Stout or Porter:** Excellent with barbecue, chocolate desserts, or smoked meats.

Beer's carbonation refreshes the palate and balances salty or fried foods beautifully.

Cocktails & Spirits

Cocktails can complement or contrast a dish.

• **Martini:** Pairs well with seafood and briny appetizers.

• **Old Fashioned:** Matches nicely with steak or smoked meats.

• **Margarita:** Perfect with Mexican or spicy cuisine.

• **Neat Whiskey or Bourbon:**

Best enjoyed after dinner as a digestif.

Cocktails tend to be stronger, so they're often ideal before or after the meal rather than throughout.

Consider Regional Pairings

A simple rule of thumb: what grows together goes together. Italian wines with Italian dishes, French wine with French cuisine, Mexican beer with Mexican food — these pairings naturally complement one another because they evolved side by side.

Sweet with Sweet

When serving dessert, make sure the drink is at least as sweet as the dish. A dry wine paired with a sugary dessert can taste bitter. Dessert wines, port, or a rich stout are excellent options.

When in Doubt

• Choose a versatile option like Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, or a pilsner.

• Ask your server or sommelier for guidance.

• Order by the glass if you're unsure.

• Trust your personal preference — the best pairing is one you enjoy.

Final Thought

Pairing alcohol with food isn't about strict rules — it's about balance, harmony, and enjoyment. When thoughtfully chosen, the right beverage doesn't overpower the meal; it enhances it. With a little practice, you'll turn every dinner into a curated dining experience.

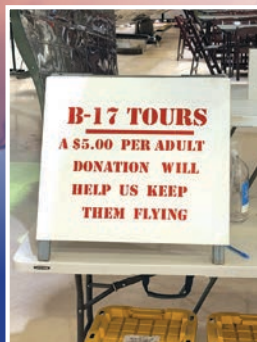

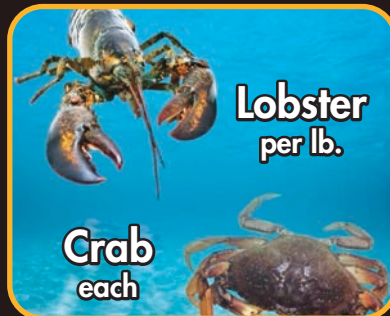
